

## CSO's 76<sup>th</sup> Season 2018-19

Join us for our 2018-19 season; we have an exciting and varied programme planned with works by Stravinsky, Strauss, Tchaikovsky, Sibelius, Vaughan-Williams, Saint-Saens, Delius and Rachmaninov! Large works feature in this Season starting with Tchaikovsky Symphony No.5 in November, The Firebird and Sibelius 2nd Symphony in April's concert. The February concert contrasts shorter pieces including the Capuzzi Double Bass Concerto with our own Gareth Harrison taking the soloist role.

A discount is available for those who buy a season ticket to the three Sunday evening St Faiths Concerts.

The Season starts with our Family Concert on Saturday October 20th. Following the success of the 'Myth and Magic Concert' in February we will be presenting a short concert of exciting orchestral music, with the theme of 'Dance'. There will be songs to sing with the orchestra and activities to involve young audience members. A lively presentation in a Family atmosphere for all to catch an enthusiasm for the sound of a large orchestra and to join in the music making.

Our Season concludes with a collaboration with Wirral Symphony Orchestra when we will combine forces to perform the 'Alpine Symphony' by Richard Strauss. We are delighted that Thelma Handy Leader of R.L.P.O will be the soloist for the Tchaikovsky Violin Concerto with the Orchestra in what promises to be an epic finalé to the 76th Season.
